On behalf of the Industrial Energy Consumers of America (IECA) and its member companies, we strongly support the Certificate of Public Convenience to construct and operate the Southeast Supply Enhancement Project. Currently there is no firm pipeline capacity that is available to allow manufacturing companies on the East Coast to invest capital, increase production, and create jobs. The pipeline would increase supply by 1.5 billion cubic feet per day to Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, and Alabama. Increased pipeline capacity is necessary to reshore jobs, strengthen supply chains, and national security.
